CLOSE THE WAGE GAP FOR WOMEN!

Five Actions You Can Take to Close the Wage Gap

1. **Join the ACLU's Action Network.** Sign up to find out important ways that you can take action to help us end the wage gap. Visit www.aclu.org and click on "SIGN UP" (right column). We'll provide further information on other exciting opportunities to join in our campaign to end the pay disparity.
2. **Write a Letter to the Editor.** Get the word out through newspapers, newsletters, blogs, personal websites, academic publications and more. If you get a letter placed, e-mail us the link to your letter at field@aclu.org
3. **Call your senator.** Call the Capitol Switchboard at 202-224-3121 and have them connect you to your senator. Once connected, tell your senator to support and seek swift passage of the Paycheck Fairness Act, S. 182. Call Georgia's Senators directly at

4. **Ask five of people in your address book to take action.** Ask 5 or more of your friends, family, colleagues, neighbors, or whoever is part of your social network to call their senators and ask them to support the Paycheck Fairness Act.
5. **Meet with your senators.** You can meet with your senator and urge them to support the Paycheck Fairness Act, S. 182. Ask him or her to take action by co-sponsoring the bill and asking Senate Leadership to move the bill to the floor for a vote. If they are undecided, ask them what other information they need about the bill and let us know at field@aclu.org so we can get them that information. If they say no to co-sponsorship, ask your senator if we can count on their vote in support of the bill. If not, ask them what their concerns are about the bill and let us know.

Also, sometimes senators hold town halls or other events when they are back home - call their local office to find out if they are holding any local events. Ask them at the event to support the Paycheck Fairness Act.
