### **The Truth about Sex and Race Selection Bans**

**SB 529 is a thinly veiled attempt to restrict women's access to abortion care.**

- This is political interference in a woman's most personal, private medical decisions and her trusted relationship with her doctor. We should be working to ensure that all women have access to quality medical care, including contraceptive services, prenatal care, and abortion.
- Instead of working to ensure that all women can get the health care and services they need, proponents of SB 529 use false information concerning the location of abortion providers within communities of color to advance their own political agenda.
- This legislation writes discrimination into our laws and raises serious constitutional concerns.

**SB 529 interferes with a woman's ability to make the best decision for herself and her family regarding whether and when to have a child.**

- The real purpose of this bill is to intimidate and shame a woman who decides to obtain abortion care.
- SB 529 discriminates against women of color by allowing politicians to question their private family decisions.
- Instead of ensuring access to quality care, this legislation will drive women, especially women of color, away from the health care system.

**We can all agree that sexism and racism are complex problems that need comprehensive, long-term solutions.**

- Our legislature should devote time and resources to ensuring that all women can get the health care they need. We need laws and policies that improve the lives of women, their families, and their communities.
