## JOINT MOTION TO DISMISS

Petitioners Elizabeth Handy and Bilal Walk and Defendants Brenda
Fitzgerald, M.D. and Donna L. Moore jointly move to dismiss this action as moot.
Petitioners filed this action, a Verified Petition for Writ of Mandamus, on March
22, 2017. Petitioners requested that Defendants comply with their mandatory legal
duties under O.C.G.A. § 31-10-9(e)(5) to issue a birth certificate for their infant
daughter, "in the surname ... as designated by both parents" in a signed and
notarized acknowledgment of legitimation form. The Petitioners also requested

that the birth certificate be duly recorded in the Vital Records of the State of Georgia.

Since the filing of the Verified Petition, Defendants have complied with their mandatory duty under O.C.G.A. § 31-10-9(e)(5). On April 5, 2017, Donna L. Moore, the State Registrar and Director of the State Office of Vital Records, issued the birth certificate for Petitioners' infant daughter, as requested, bearing the name of their child as designated by both parents. The birth certificate has been duly recorded in the Vital Records of the State of Georgia. Ms. Moore issued a certified copy of the birth certificate to the Petitioners on April 10, 2017, which Petitioners received on April 12, 2017.

The public duty under O.C.G.A. § 31-10-9(e)(5) to enter the surname on the birth certificate as designated by both parents has now occurred, and Petitioners have obtained the relief they sought in this action. Accordingly, the Petition for Writ of Mandamus is moot. *See R.A.F. v. Robinson*, 286 Ga. 644, 646 (2010). For these reasons, the parties jointly move to dismiss this action. For the Court's convenience, the parties attach a proposed order as Exhibit A to this Motion.
