Before the Court is “Appellant Brian Kemp’s Emergency Motion for Stay of Injunction Pending Appeal.” As to Appellant’s request for a stay pending appeal, the motion is DENIED, as Appellant has not made the requisite showing. *See Nken v. Holder*, 556 U.S. 418, 434 (2009).
