ABOUT THE SURVEY

Background

Three weeks after the U.S. Supreme Court overturned *Roe v. Wade*, the 11th Circuit Court of Appeals lifted a district court's injunction, putting H.B. 481 into effect immediately. A week later, abortion providers and advocates filed a new state constitutional challenge, seeking to block the state's six-week ban. A request to temporarily block the law was denied by a state court, but the challenge to the ban will proceed in state courts.

Methodology

The survey of likely Georgia voters was conducted using live operators from August 4 through August 17, 2022. Participants were selected from a pool of registered voters with a history of voting in General, Primary and Runoff elections. They were randomly dialed and then weighted based on the projected turnout. Responses were collected using live operators who dialed cell phones and landlines. It should be noted that 40% of the respondents self-identified as Republican and 32% self-identified as Democrat, which likely means the results skew slightly more conservative than Georgia. Georgia tilted Republican by 1.5% in the 2018 election, as defined by candidate support, and slightly Democrat based on the 2020 General Election.






What do you think is the MOST important issue facing the country today?




In general, do you think the country is headed in the right direction or wrong direction?




Which of the following do you think is the law in Georgia?




Which of the following would you support as being the law in Georgia?




Do you believe Georgians have a general right to privacy in making decisions related to their bodies?




Do you agree or disagree with the recent Supreme Court decision to overturn *Roe v. Wade* and to limit a woman's access to abortion?




Do you believe Georgians should have the choice to have an abortion up to 20 weeks of pregnancy?




True or False: Women who have miscarriages may be subject to investigations from authorities to determine if they had a miscarriage or an abortion.




True or False: Pregnant women who lose their baby may not be able to receive medical care because their physician is concerned about jeopardizing their medical license.




Do you believe that the state should have the power to force a woman to stay pregnant?




Do you believe women should be criminally investigated and prosecuted for possibly having an abortion?




To what extent, if any, will the decision to limit a woman's access to abortion affect for whom you will vote?




Do you support or oppose extending Medicaid in Georgia to provide health insurance to working Georgians who cannot afford insurance AND to help keep hospitals open?




Do you believe that the government and law enforcement should have extended powers to search computers and apps on your phone?







Doctors could limit the advice and care they give to a woman if they believe she is pregnant.**




In your opinion, should contraception, such as IUDs and Plan B pills, also known as the morning after pill, be legal or illegal in Georgia?
