## Reproductive Rights Scorecard Methodology

#### Who are we?

The ACLU of Georgia envisions a state that guarantees all persons the civil liberties and rights contained in the United States and Georgia Constitutions and Bill of Rights. The ACLU of Georgia enhances and defends the civil liberties and rights of all Georgians through legal action, legislative and community advocacy and civic education and engagement. We are an inclusive, nonpartisan, statewide organization powered by our members, donors and active volunteers.

#### How do we select the bills to analyze?

Throughout the ACLU's history, great strides have been made to protect women's rights, including women's suffrage, education, women entering the workforce, and most recently, the Me Too Movement. Despite this incredible progress, women still face discrimination and are forced to constantly defend challenges to their ability to make private decisions about reproductive health. Overall, women make just 78 cents for every dollar earned by men. Black women earn only 64 cents and Latinas earn only 54 cents for each dollar earned by white men.

Nationally, Georgia is among the worst states in terms of reproductive health. It has the highest maternal mortality rate in the country and in 2019, the Georgia legislature enacted one of the most restrictive anti-choice bills in the country. The ACLU of Georgia was the lead organization in striking down this six-week ban in court.

The COVID-19 pandemic has revealed even greater gender-oriented fissures in our society. Women, and particularly women of color, are disproportionately impacted by the pandemic — they are more likely to lose their jobs, more likely to work in essential jobs on the frontlines of the pandemic and more likely to struggle with school closures and the loss of childcare for their children. COVID-19 gives this work even more urgency.

In order to provide a comprehensive look at recent reproductive and women's rights legislation in Georgia, we chose bills covering a variety of related issues, from the right to choose to increasing healthcare coverage for new mothers to preserving and expanding the rights of incarcerated people who are pregnant.

#### Which bills did we choose, and why?

To ensure a thorough review of Georgia's reproductive justice and women's rights bills, we scored eight bills dating back to 2012. Each legislator was scored on bills they voted on since being elected (absences and excuses were not counted towards the score). Because the bills we chose were voted on throughout the years of 2012 to 2020, some legislators are scored on a different number of bills because they were not present in the legislature when every bill scored was voted on or they were absent/excused from the vote — these nuances are reflected in the voters and scoring.

# How does the scoring work and what do the scores mean?

- 1. First, we chose which bills to score legislators on. We settled on eight bills in total, all of which encompass a wide range of reproductive justice issues.
- 2. For each bill, we reviewed each legislator's corresponding votes (yes (Y) or no (N)).
- 3. We then dictated which vote, yes (Y) or no (N), would align with the ACLU of Georgia's mission to protect the reproductive rights of all Georgians. Each legislator received one point if they voted in line with the ACLU of Georgia's stance on the bill and each legislator received zero points if they voted against the ACLU of Georgia's stance on a bill. If the

legislator was absent or excused, we did not score them for that bill and it was not taken into account in their overall score.

- 4. To tally up the scores for each legislator, we divided the total number of applicable reproductive rights and justice bills the legislator voted on by the sum of legislator's scores. This gave us the amount of times that the legislator voted with a pro-civil liberties stance.
- 5. For the legislators, we only scored legislators who were set to be on the Nov. 3, 2020 ballot as of Monday Aug. 10, 2020.
- 6. The votes reviewed for scoring were the final votes for the bills, in each chamber.

### **Bills Being Scored**

### HB 954 (2012): 20-Week Abortion Ban ACLU Position: NO = 1 point

House Bill 954 was passed in 2012, and it placed a ban on abortions at 20 weeks or later. The bill only provided exceptions in two limited circumstances — to protect the life of the mother, or to preserve the fetus. Abortion bans have nothing to do with saving lives or protecting the interests of children. History shows us that anti-abortion efforts are rooted in white supremacy, the ex-

ploitation of Black women and placing women's bodies in service of men. Abortion bans are about maximizing wealth and consolidating power. Abortion is a constitutionally protected right, and the ACLU of Georgia firmly believes that people should be able to make their own decisions about whether and when to become a parent without the interference of politicians. Georgia needs legislators who will fight to protect the constitutionally protected right to abortion.

#### HB 990 (2013): Anti-Medicaid Expansion ACLU Position: NO = 1 point

HB 990 was passed in 2013 and prohibited the expansion of Medicaid eligibility through an increase in income threshold without prior legislative approval. This law restricted Georgians' access to affordable medical benefits and aid. Georgia needs lawmakers who do not allow political and partisan agendas to restrict the rights and privileges of its citizens.

#### SB 98 (2014): Abortion Opt-Out ACLU Position: NO = 1 point

SB 98 was passed in 2014 and prohibited abortion insurance coverage under any qualified health plan through state law, federal law, or exchange created through the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act. It made sure to articulate that no part of the Georgia law could be construed as creating or recognizing a person's right to abortion. This law further increased restrictions to abortion access thereby violating the rights of people to make their own decisions about their body and whether or not to become a parent. Georgia needs legislators who recognize abortion care is healthcare.

#### SB 308 (2016): Anti-Abortion Pregnancy Planning

ACLU Position: NO = 1 point

Senate Bill 308 was passed in 2016 and established a Positive Alternatives for Pregnancy Grant Program to award grants to Crisis Pregnancy Centers, nonprofits that offer pregnancy

support and encourage childbirth instead of abortion. The organization cannot receive grant money if they encourage an abortion, provide an abortion, or refer a someone to an abortion clinic. If the person's life is threatened by the pregnancy, the organization may suggest an abortion without losing the grant. CPC's are typically run by anti-choice organizations, many of whom mislead patients considering abortion and provide false information<sup>1</sup>. SB 308 makes it more difficult for people to get access to accurate information and interferes with a person's right to choose, and uses taxpayers dollars to do it. Georgia needs legislators who will fight to protect the constitutionally protected right to abortion.

#### SB 201 (2017): Family CARES Act ACLU Position: YES = 1 point

Senate Bill 201 was passed in 2017 and allowed employees to use their sick leave to care for immediate family members, including children, a spouse, parents, grandparents or any other dependents. The ACLU of Georgia works to ensure all people have equal access to employment free from gender discrimination. Since the responsi-

bility of caring for family and children is typically left to women, SB 201 saves individuals from having to make the choice between paying their bills and taking care of their families, thereby working towards the ACLU of Georgia's goal of equal access to employment. The bill is not as expansive as it could be as it only applies to companies with existing sick leave policies and limits the number of sick days to five days per year. However, SB 201 is a step in the right direction. Georgia needs legislators who fight for equal employment access regardless of gender or parenting status.

# HB 345 (2019): Anti-Shackling ACLU Position: YES = 1 point

HB 345 was passed in 2019 and prohibits law enforcement officers from using physical restraints on a pregnant person or a person in the immediate postpartum period. Shackling pregnant people during active labor and childbirth is all too common in our nation's prisons, despite it endangering the health of both the mother and the fetus. The bill also allows for pregnant prisoners to skip the squat and cough portion of a strip search and to forgo any vaginal examination, which are

both humiliating and demeaning, and can often become traumatic for a pregnant person. Additionally, HB 345 requires that any pregnant person or person who is in the immediate postpartum period not be placed in solitary confinement or in administrative segregation. The ACLU of Georgia sees prohibiting these inhumane practices for pregnant prisoners as a monumental step for both reproductive rights and prisoners' rights. Georgia needs legislators who believe that pregnant prisoners are worthy of human decency and respect.

#### HB 481 (2019); 6-Week Abortion Ban ACLU Position: NO = 1 point

Prior to being deemed unconstitutional in 2020, HB 481 was passed in 2019 and effectively banned nearly all instances of abortion after six weeks of pregnancy. Very few exceptions were made to the ban and the bill legally recognized unborn children as natural persons, allowing them to qualify as dependent minors for tax purposes and required that they be included in population-based determinations. The right to an abortion is constitutionally protected and will continue to exist despite attempted legislative interferences like HB 481. Health care in any

specialty should be patient-centered, and medical decisions should remain between the patient and the patient's physician, without political interference. Georgia needs legislators who will respect the Constitution and not infringe upon a person's right to choose.

# HB 1114(2020): Postpartum Medicaid Expansion

**ACLU Position: YES = 1 point** 

HB 1114, passed in 2020, expands maternal medicaid coverage. It provides coverage for lactation care and services for pregnant and lactating people and to their children who are breastfeeding. It also extends medicaid coverage for postpartum services to six months after birth. This legislation is critical as Georgia has a maternal mortality crisis: Georgia ranks 50th in maternal mortality rates in the US. The maternal death rate for Black women in Georgia is twice that for white women in Georgia, and six times the rate for white women, nationally. The ACLU of Georgia firmly believes this bill is a crucial step towards improving maternal outcomes and addressing the pre-and postnatal care inequities in the state. Georgia needs legislators who will fight to protect mothers and reproductive rights.
