Last night at the Presidential debate, the President used his platform to suppress the vote, encourage voter intimidation, lie about the security of mail-in voting, and indicated he would not accept the election results should he be voted out of office.

You have the right as a citizen to cast your ballot in the manner that is best for you. We encourage you to vote by mail, [vote early](#), or vote in person on Election Day. Make your choice, and [make a plan](#).

We are resolute in our actions to ensure *every eligible voter can access the ballot*. We're asking each of you to join us in the 34 days between now and election day.

1. **Sign up to be a [poll worker](#)**. Poll workers are urgently needed to ensure lines are moving, machines are working, and that everyone who shows up to vote, can do so.
2. **Call voters**. There is so much at stake in this election from the top ticket all the way down to local races. *Every vote counts, and every voter we reach is more likely to vote*. Sign up at [acluga.org/phonebanks](https://acluga.org/phonebanks).
3. **Absentee Ballot Rejections**. If you or someone you know has had their ballot wrongly rejected, let us know by emailing [ballots@acluga.org](mailto:ballots@acluga.org).
