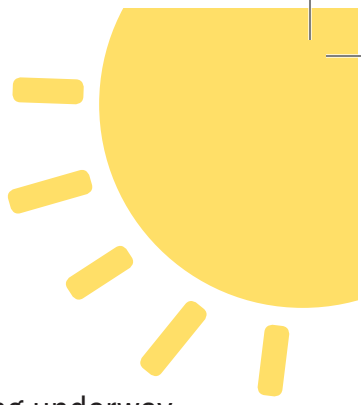


FAIR DISTRICTS. TRANSPARENCY. ACCOUNTABILITY.

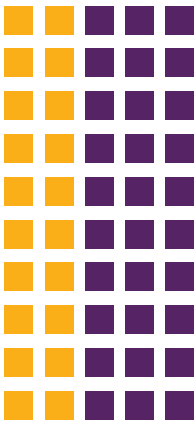


The Problem

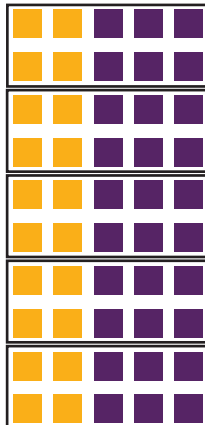
Once again, legislators will be drawing district lines to protect their own seats, protect the status quo, and/or to benefit the political party in power. This is unfair, and WE must end it!

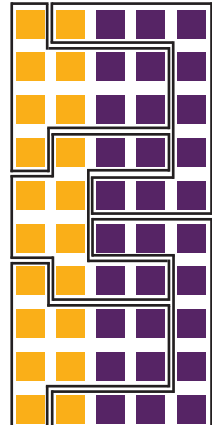
60% purple districts
